Sophie Trull, 84, of Topeka, passed away peacefully on Friday, January 9, 2015 at St. Francis Health Center.

Sophie was born on April 16, 1930 in Topeka, the daughter of John and Catherine Duman Stadler. She attended grade school at Sacred Heart and went to Capitol Catholic High School graduating in 1948. She married Stanley Trull in 1958 and together they raised two sons and were married for more than 50 years. Stan preceded her in death on April 18, 2009.
