Philip Stephen Crow, Jr. 70, Topeka, passed away Friday, October 22, 2010. Steve was born December 26, 1939 in Topeka, the son of The Rev. Philip S. Crow, Sr. and Zella Marguerite Carver Crow. He graduated from Field Kinley High in Coffeyville in 1958 and earned his Bachelor of Pharmacy from the University of Kansas in 1964. On December 21, 1963, Steve and Joan Marie Oswald were united in marriage in Lawrence KS. They enjoyed almost 47 years together. Steve began his pharmacy career in Dodge City, returning to Topeka for a position at Jayhawk Pharmacy before serving at the VA Hospital. In 1968 he accepted the Director of Pharmacy at St. Francis Hospital. In 1985, Steve and Joan purchased Carbondale Pharmacy where he worked until his retirement in 2000. He was a life member of the KU Alumni Assoc., a member of the Kansas and American Pharmacy Assoc., and was past President of Kansas Hospital Pharmacy Assoc. Steve was a member of the Episcopal Church. He was an avid KU fan and a wonderful "Papa". Survivors include his wife, Joan Crow; son, Chris (LeAnn) Crow and their children, Austin and Logan; and son, Brad (Gretchen) Crow and their daughter, Ashley; his brothers, Raymond Crow, Casper WY, and Vincent Crow, Gig Harbor WA. Funeral service will be at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Road, Topeka KS 66614, where family will greet friends one hour prior to service.
