Steven Roy Wrenn, 66, formerly of Topeka, Kansas, passed away unexpectedly of natural causes at his home in Hanna, Wyoming.

Steve was born September 9, 1951, in Topeka, the son of Roy and Agnes Mock Wrenn. He attended Holy Name Grade School and graduated from Hayden Catholic High School in 1969. Steve graduated from Stormont-Vail School of Nursing in 1984 as a registered nurse and then earned his Bachelor of Science degree from Fort Hays State University. Steve was a surgical nurse at St. Francis Hospital for over 30 years prior to retirement.
