Terry Lee Durow, 74, Topeka, Kansas, passed away at his home on Wednesday, April 13, 2022.

Terry was born in Topeka, on October 19, 1947, the son of Lloyd and Germaine Dohrman Durow. He graduated from Hayden High School in 1965 and served in the United States Army. He retired from Benchmark Motors as a Service Manager in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Following retirement, he started NeedAMow Lawn Care in Topeka. Terry enjoyed 32 loving years with his best friend and wife, Lois Stadler-Durow. 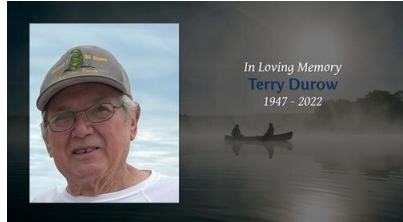

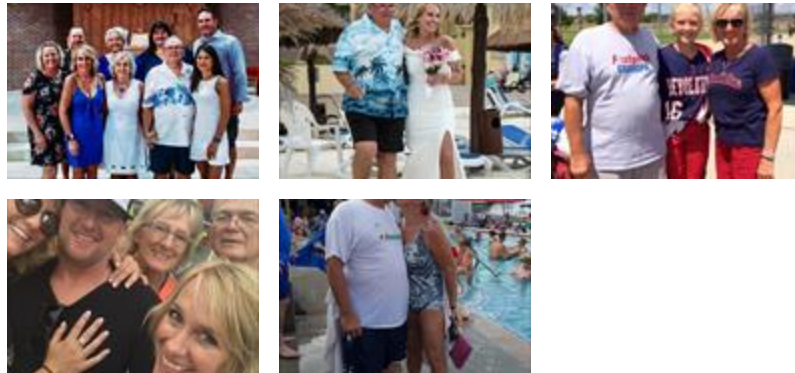
