Thomas Paul Ingenthron, 83, Topeka, passed away February 9, 2007. Thomas was born May 24, 1923 in Grantville KS the son of John N. and Agnes M. (Quinlan) Ingenthron. He graduated from Perry High School in 1941. Tom served in the U.S Army from 1943 to 1946, during which time he fought in WWII in Europe and the Pacific. Tom married Marcia Jean Bigham September 3, 1947 at Assumption Catholic Church. Tom graduated from Kansas State University in 1950 with a Bachelors degree. He graduated from Emporia State University with a Masters degree in 1971. He taught and coached for 35 years in the Ozawkie, Emmett, Bern, Victoria, Topeka and Perry-Lecompton school districts. In 1985 he retired. After retirement he continued his passion for fishing, camping and cabinet making. He was preceded in death by his parents, and a brother, John Ingenthron.
