Thomas Eugene Olson, 80, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Wednesday, December 18, 2024, after a short illness.

Tom was born January 17, 1944. He attended Holy Name Catholic Grade School and graduated from Hayden High School in 1962. On August 17, 1963, Tom and Janice Hilderman were united in marriage celebrating 61 years together. They are members of Sacred Heart -St. Joseph Parish.

Tom spent 35 years working for Santa Fe Railroad, which later became BNSF, in the accounting department retiring as a manager. He was fortunate to retire early in his late fifties. Enjoying the freedom of retirement, he and Janice were able to enjoy life traveling, playing golf and spending time with family and friends. Tom's greatest joy came from coaching baseball and basketball, attending activities and events and cheering on sports teams for his children and grandchildren. He rarely missed their activities.
