January 1, 1753 - December 1, 2010

Thomas Leroy Perry, 93, Topeka, passed away Monday, Nov. 29, 2010. Mr. Perry was born Nov. 16, 1917 on a farm near Emmett, the son of Thomas H. and Nora L. Loughmiller Perry. He married Margaret Mary McMullen on March 26, 1940 in Emmett. The couple farmed in the Emmett area until moving to Topeka in 1946. From 1947 to 1982, Mr. Perry was a superintendent for Thompson Dehydrating. After retirement they enjoyed traveling.
