



Ursula A. McMullen Anders

January 3, 1921 - December 8, 2008

Ursula A. McMullen Anders, 87, of Topeka, died Monday, December 8, 2008 in Sabetha Community Hospital. Mrs. Anders was born January 3, 1921 in Emmett, the daughter of Louis C. and Pearl M. Fitzhugh McMullen. She attended school in Emmett and St. Mary College, Leavenworth and was a graduate of St. Francis Hospital School of Nursing. Ursula served in the US Army Nurse Corp as a 1Lt. during WWII. She worked for the federal government for 25 years at the Topeka Supply Depot Dispensary, Forbes Air Force Base Hospital and the Air National Guard Dispensary before she retired. Ursula also worked three years at the Kansas Correctional Vocational Training Center in Topeka. Mrs. Anders was a member of Mater Dei (Holy Name) Parish and Altar Guild, St. Francis Hospital Nurses Alumni, the American Legion Post No. 1, VFW Post 1650 Ladies Auxiliary, National Assoc. of Retired Federal Employees and Women of the Moose. On March 28, 1946, Ursula and William R. "Bill" Anders were married. He preceded her in death April 22, 1985. Also preceding her were her son, William D. Anders; her sisters, Thelma L. Heston and Delores L. Murden; and two brothers, William J. McMullen and L. Leo McMullen. Survivors include two daughters, Barbara J. Spellmeier and Janet R. Anders, both of Fairview; three sisters, Margaret M. Perry, Topeka, Betty A. Parker, Louisville KY and Darlene Woodruff, Overbrook; brothers, Myron C. McMullen, Topeka and Francis R.
