VA Prosser, 81, Topeka, Kansas, passed away on Monday, August 12, 2024.

VA was born February 11, 1943, in Overland Park, Kansas, the son of Virgil Alvin Prosser and Novella Alice Plettner. He graduated from Lindon High School in 1961, where he played football and was home coming king senior year. He enjoyed playing the drums.

VA joined the United States Army in 1961 and served until 1967. During his time in the military as a Quartermaster, he was stationed in Garmisch Partenkirchen, Bavaria, Germany, where he met Sonja Emma Maria Kabrhelova, of Garmisch Partenkirchen. Sonja worked on the base and they dated during this time and reunited in the United States where Sonja emigrated, and ultimately married VA in 1965.

After his honorable discharge from the Army, VA spent his career at Santa Fe Railway in Topeka as an internal audit supervisor. He enjoyed spending time with family and took a leadership role in his son's Boy Scout Troop 175, managing troop accounting and travelling on high adventure trips including Philmont in New Mexico and climbing 14ers in Colorado. He was very active with his grandchildren having the opportunity be a big part of their lives growing up.

VA is survived by his beloved wife, Sonja; two sons, Brian of Kansas City, and Curtis of Topeka; grandchildren, Colin, Morgan, and Owen of Kansas City; and his brother, Max of Topeka. He was preceded in death by his parents and siblings, Linda and Patricia.
