



## Valerie Ingenthron

September 13, 1933 - December 7, 2020

Valerie Louise Nicholas Ingenthron, 87, Topeka Kansas, passed away peacefully at home surrounded by her family on Monday, December 7, 2020. Heaven has gained, yet another angel.

Valerie was born September 13, 1933, the daughter of Thomas and Mabel Nicholas and grew up in Havensville, Kansas. She married Joseph John Ingenthron on August 2, 1958, in Topeka where they raised their children in the big stone “Billard House”, in the Oakland area.

Anyone who knew Valerie will always remember her for her beautiful smile, giving nature and kind eyes. She spent countless hours, over the years, making baby blankets, burping rags and maternity clothes for Birth Right and scrubbing donated toys, dolls and stuffed animals for Let’s Help. No matter how many mouths she had to feed there was always room for one more at her dinner table. The countless pets that “followed” her children home always had a warm place to sleep, until or if their owners were found.

Valerie was preceded in death by her husband, John Ingenthron, and son, Bill Ingenthron.

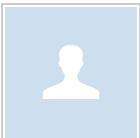
