Vera Jane Lackey, 81, passed away peacefully on June 8, 2024, in Topeka, Kansas, after a courageous battle with cancer. She was born on January 11, 1943, to Trinidad Avila Duarte and Ruth Vargas Duarte.

She grew up in Hutchinson, Kansas and graduated from Hutchinson High School in 1961. She met the love of her life, Mike Lackey, and later they got married on May 18, 1963. Together, they had three wonderful daughters.

Vera's lifelong career was running an in-home daycare for 36 years which also provided a preschool program for many years. She touched many young lives in these 36 years running this daycare. She brought much comfort to parents by providing a safe place for their children to stay. Her business was very successful not only due to her entrepreneurial spirit, but because she was compassionate. She cared for the children as if they were her own. Between being a mother, grandmother, and daycare provider, Vera felt her calling to the world and was very successful at shaping young minds. Vera was a member of Epsilon Sigma Alpha Sorority, Every Women's Resource Center, member of State and National Day Care Provider organizations, which she helped and led seminars on daycare locally and nationally, she also helped passionately with the funeral luncheons at Most Pure Heart of Mary Catholic Church.
