Verle W. Kufahl, 91, Topeka, passed away Saturday, April 9, 2016.

Verle was born May 6, 1924, in Beatrice NE, the son of Walter and Grace Hartwich Kufahl. Verle was united in marriage to Dolores Teske on January 5, 1944, at St. Luke Lutheran Church in Wheaton KS. She preceded him in death on June 17, 2013, after 69 years of marriage.

Verle proudly served in the United States Army during WWII in the 158th RCT Bushmasters, seeing action in the Philippines and participating in the occupation of Japan. He maintained life-long friendships with his WWII regiment buddies, often traveling to visit them. Verle retired from Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company after 35 years of employment. Following retirement, Verle worked for Tilton's Market for 14 years.

Verle is survived by sons, Lyndon (Anne) Kufahl of Topeka, Bruce (Lorie) Kufahl of Galveston TX, Brent Kufahl of Topeka; seven grandchildren and 10 great-grandchildren.

He was also preceded in death by a son, Stan Kufahl and two brothers, Kenneth and Merle.
