Victor I. Barber, 81, Topeka, died Saturday, June 19, 2004 at the Topeka VA Medical Center.

He was born May 5, 1923 in Chechota, OK, the son of James and Mahala Boatman Barber. He came to Topeka in 1946 where he met his bride, Doris Payton. They were married June 6, 1947. He was a wonderful husband and father and will be missed by many.

Mr. Barber was a highly decorated veteran that served in the U. S. Navy during WWII on the USS Tennessee. He worked at Goodyear Tire and Rubber for 23 years and then spent 21 years as owner of Vic Barber Construction, building homes. He was a member of United Rubber Workers #307, Topeka Home Builders Assoc., VFW, American Legion and the Eagles.
