Victor Raymond passed away at his home in Topeka, Kansas on October 24, 2015.

He was born Vittorio Sacco on November 14, 1946, in Petralia Soprana, Italy to Bartolo and Lucia Sacco. At age 5 he immigrated to the United States and was later adopted by Philip and Rose Raymond of Chicago. Victor grew up in Chicago until enlisting in the United States Air Force in 1965. He served in the Vietnam War before being honorably discharged in 1971. On November 1, 1968, he married Glenda Schwabe of Topeka. They later divorced. He worked as an electrician for many years and later was employed as an auditor for the State of Kansas and the United States Department of Defense. Victor graduated from Wright City College of Chicago in 1971 and Washburn University in 1978.
