Viola Rose Murray, 71, of Auburn KS passed away, May 24, 2014, at her home. She was born March 15, 1943, in Beatrice NE to Ruthger Clark and Nina Bell Finch Frahm. She was raised in Buchard NE, graduating from Summerfield High School in 1960. On May 29, 1960 she married Gene D. Murray in Summerfield KS at the United Presbyterian Church.
