January 1, 1923 - August 10, 2012

Virginia Elizabeth Latshaw, Topeka, born Oct. 16, 1923, passed away on Aug. 6, 2012, at Brewster Health Center. She was the fourth of twelve children born to Joseph and Marie Stadler. Four survive her, Louis Stadler, James Stadler, Jerome Stadler and Rita Harvan. Virginia married Harvey L. Latshaw on May 31, 1948, at Assumption Catholic Church in Topeka, Kansas. He preceded her in death. Virginia attended Sacred Heart Grade School and graduated from Seaman High School. Before marrying, she worked as a teletype operator for Santa Fe Railroad for seven years. Virginia was an active member of Most Pure Heart of Mary Catholic Church until her relocation to Brewster Retirement Community Center. While rearing her family she was active in Girl Scouts and Boy Scouts as a leader. She is survived by her four adult children, Stephanie (Ruben) Perez, Kenneth (Ruth) Latshaw, Sam (Karen) Latshaw and Patty (Greg) Halling; nine grandchildren; and five great-grandchildren. Carson Bowman, a great-grandson, preceded her in death in Feb. 2012. Mrs. Latshaw will lie in state from 3 to 7:30 p.m. Friday at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW Urish Road, Topeka KS 66614, where a parish rosary will be prayed at 6 p.m. Family will greet friends following the rosary until 7:30 p.m. Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at Most Pure Heart of Mary Church. Burial will be at Mt. Calvary Cemetery.
