January 1, 1933 - January 21, 2008

Virginia D. (Orozco) (Gomez) Ochoa, 74, Topeka, passed away Fri., Jan. 18, 2008. The daughter of Jose and Lucille Orozco, Virginia was born Oct. 16, 1933 in Topeka. She graduated from Our Lady of Guadalupe Grade School in 1947 and Hayden High in 1951. She attended Clark's School of Business in 1953 while working at The Camera Shop processing pictures. She was a State of Kansas employee for the Dept. of Social and Rehabilitation Services, Division of Children and Youth, for 38 years until her retirement in 1996. She was awarded a certificate of appreciation from Children and Youth Social Services and a certificate for dedication and meritorious service from the Governor of Kansas and the Secretary of SRS. In 1957, she married Alfred S. Gomez. They divorced. She married Augustine R. Ochoa in 1977 and they later divorced. Virginia is survived by two daughters, Gina R. Valdez and Lisa K. Barnes; two sons, Michael R. Gomez, all of Topeka, and Christopher O. Gomez, Wichita; a brother, Joseph C. Orozco, Jr. of Chula Vista, CA; 11 grandchildren and 1 great-grandson; 3 nieces and 6 great-nephews in CA. A son, Anthony Gomez, preceded her in death in 1994.
