Warren Dale Hall, 80, Topeka, Kansas, passed away Friday, February 26, 2021.

Warren was born May 28, 1940, in Holton, Kansas, to Edward and Maysol Bennett Hall. He attended grade school at Sunny Slope, Soldier, Kansas, attended Holton High School for three and one-half years and graduated from Nortonville High School in 1959. Warren worked at Goodyear for 13 years. He owned and operated Hall's Oldsmobile Salvage at Soldier. He also owned Hall's Painting for many years until he retired and moved to Topeka. Warren and Mary Ann Weishaar were married at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Nortonville October 22, 1960. She passed away February 25, 2020.

Warren was a member of Mother Teresa of Calcutta Catholic Church and a Third Degree member of the Knights of Columbus. He was a past member of the Delia Lions Club, Kansas City Arrowhead Pontiac Club and Oldsmobile Club of America for 15 years.

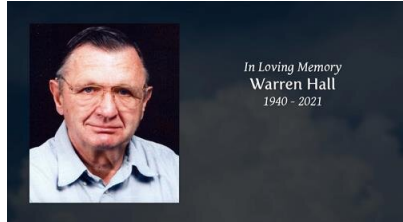
