William "Billy" Joseph Weber, 55, of Topeka, Kansas passed away suddenly on September 30, 2023, in Seneca, Kansas while visiting family.

Billy was born October 14, 1967, in Parma, Ohio, the son of Rail and JoAn (Sasak) Weber. 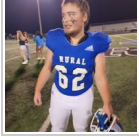
