William A. "Bill" Boggs, 65, left this world Thursday, April 28, 2005 after a courageous battle with cancer.

Bill was an aircraft technician in the Air Force and was then a Tech Sargeant for the 190th Air Refueling Group for over 20 years, retiring in August of 1990.
