William J. "Bill" Fugate, 70, died Tuesday, August 31, 2004, at home. Bill was born October 9, 1933 in Macomb IL, the son of James and Lucille Shogrin Fugate. Bill and his family moved to Topeka soon after his birth. He attended East Topeka Jr. High and Topeka High School.
