



Wilma Jeanette Hudson

August 27, 1917 - December 6, 2008

Wilma Jeanette Hudson, 91, formerly of Topeka, passed away Wednesday, Dec. 3, 2008 at a Holton nursing care facility with her beloved granddaughter and son at her side. She was born August 27, 1917 in Holton, the daughter of William C. and Alice (McNutt) Wischmeier. Wilma was a graduate of Denison High School and Clark's Business School of Topeka, and worked for several years as a secretary for Hall Lithographing, retiring from Mainline Printing in 1984. She was a devout Christian and 50 + year member of Oakland United Methodist Church. Wilma was also a 55 + year member of the Order of the Eastern Star of Meriden. She was a wonderful mother and grandmother who loved to cook and garden, but who loved her family most of all. Wilma married Bill Hudson on May 29, 1948 in Topeka. He preceded her in death in Feb. 1979. She was also preceded in death by a stepson, Bill in 2001 and a brother, Marvin Wischmeier in 2007. Survivors include a son, Dan Hudson of Topeka; a granddaughter, Crystal Hudson of New York City, NY; a stepson, John Hudson (Jan) and family of Topeka and several step grandchildren. Wilma will lie in state and the family will greet friends from 12 to 1 pm, Saturday, Dec. 6 at Kevin Brennan Family Funeral Home, 2801 SW. Urish Rd, Topeka, KS 66614, with a brief memorial service beginning at 1 pm. Burial will be private.
