York William Haines, 45, passed away Thursday, August 6, 2020.

Born to Roy Jr. and Lorna Holsapple Haines on April 30, 1975, in Topeka, Kansas, York attended Holy Name Grade School, Hayden High School, graduated from Shawnee Heights High School in 1993 and played baseball at Allen County Community College.

Beginning his technical career at Datatel in Topeka, York honed his skills and worked as an independent contractor in IT technology.

He enjoyed fishing, twice catching that year's state record for the largest bass and another year the largest carp. York liked to laugh and tell jokes, was a huge Royals and Chiefs fan, liked tall, frosty beers and loved his family, friends and his beloved dogs.
